- Dignity Closet: hygiene products are delivered to schools in KISD and NISD for children and teens that would otherwise go without.
- Quest after School: volunteers work with academically at-risk children after school at KISD and NISD campuses. Volunteers read aloud, discuss readings, and provide homework help as needed. Participating children also receive a take home book in order to build their home library.
- Snack Pack: bags are filled with kid-friendly food and delivered to Title I schools in KISD and NISD. These snack packs are distributed to meet the nutritional needs of children at risk of hunger over the weekends.
